Pre-Kindergarten

For children in the year prior to entering Kindergarten. Children must be age 4 by September 1st.

Kindergarten & 1st Grade Preparedness Class prepares children to enter Kindergarten with the necessary skills, behavior and stability they need to progress and flourish. Focus is on:

- Developing self-concept, self control, and learning positive social skills through interaction with peers.
- Participating in a variety of language and literacy activities, writing, science, math, art, music and social studies lessons.
- Physical development in the areas of large motor and fine motor skills.
- School success for all children.
- Parent involvement and support.

Opportunities are offered to children to ensure they are developmentally ready to enter Kindergarten. Parent conferences are held during the year to update on progress and to share ideas and concerns.

Classes meet 8:30 am to 3:15 pm, and students may ride the school bus if parents feel they are ready to do so. School age childcare is available through Community Education for the students in this class both before and after school for families that need to accommodate work schedules. Two sessions are available, and advance registration is required as class size is limited:

A: MONDAY & WEDNESDAY

Classes start September 9, 2024

B: TUESDAY & THURSDAY

Classes start September 10, 2024
